



Using Digital Downloads

Here are instructions for using Digital Downloads, Fairfield County District Library's source for thousands of free downloadable eBooks and eAudiobooks, available at <http://digitalbooks.moldi.org>

A. Digital Downloads (powered by OverDrive) offerings

1. Visit **Digital Downloads** at <http://digitalbooks.moldi.org>
2. Digital Downloads offers several downloadable formats. These include:
 - EPUB and PDF eBooks: These are compatible with many eReaders, including the Nook, the Sony eReader, the Literati, and the Kobo. EPUB books are compatible with the iPad.
 - Kindle Book: These are compatible with Kindle devices and Kindle reading apps.
 - MP3 Audio: These eAudiobooks are compatible with most MP3 players, including iPod. *(MP3 titles should play on iPods, but you must use iTunes to transfer OverDrive MP3 files to the device rather than using the OverDrive Media Console.)*
 - WMA Audio: These eAudiobooks are compatible with most MP3 players, including iPod.

B. How to Check Out an eBook or eAudiobook

Using your personal computer (not a library computer) with an Internet connection:

1. Visit the **Digital Downloads** section at <http://digitalbooks.moldi.org> to find a book
2. Click **Add to Cart**
3. Click **Proceed to Checkout**
4. Select **Fairfield County District Library** from the Library drop down menu
5. Type your **Library Card number** and **PIN number** in the box
6. Select **Login**
7. Click **Confirm Check Out**
8. **My Bookshelf** will display with your book

C. Transferring eBooks

How to transfer an eBook can vary depending on your device. The library has instructions for transferring eBook titles to your Nook, Kindle, iPad, Literati, Sony eReader, and Kobo. Instructions for using Adobe Digital Editions are also available. Visit the library's website at <http://www.fcdlibrary.org/reference/ebooks.php> for a copy of these instructions.

D. Transferring eAudiobooks

1. The first time you download eAudiobooks, you will need to download the free OverDrive Media Console software. To do this:
 - Click on **Required Software** on the Digital Downloads homepage.
 - Select the version of the software you need (Windows, Mac, Android, and Blackberry are some options.)
 - Click the **Download Now** button to begin the download process.
 - If you are using a Windows operating system, the first time you use OverDrive Media Console you will be prompted to complete a Windows Media Player security upgrade. Follow the instructions given in the message to complete the upgrade.
2. To download your eAudiobook that you have checked out, go to **My Bookshelf** in your Digital Downloads account.
3. Click on the title to download it to the OverDrive Media Console.
4. Once downloaded, titles can be transferred to a variety of devices, including iPods and MP3 players.
