

How do Friends Help the Library?

- Friends sponsor many educational and recreational events for all ages at the Fairfield County District Library.
- Friends sponsor children's programs, storytimes, and activities to offer positive reading and learning experiences. These programs help to build the foundation for a life-long enjoyment of books.

- Friends provide volunteer support to library staff and purchase needed equipment.

How are the Friends Funded?

- The Friends of the Library are funded by memberships, donations, memorial gifts, book sales and fundraisers.
- The Friends are a nonprofit, educational organization 501(c)(3) so any amount you donate over the \$5.00 individual membership is a charitable contribution and is tax-deductible.

How do the Friends Operate?

- The Friends Board of Trustees is elected from the membership and meets once a month. Officers are elected. Some members volunteer to chair special events, coordinate committees, assist with activities and volunteer in the Friends bookstore, Books & Such, and the Third Floor Gallery.

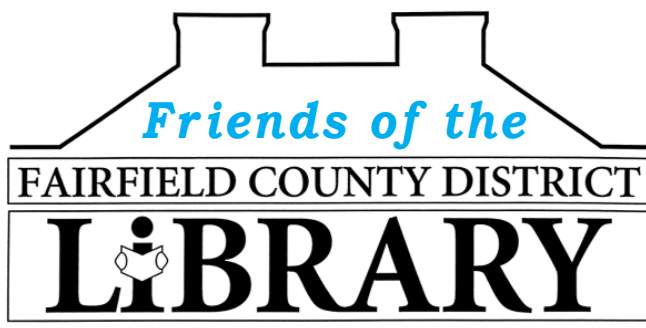
