



Using Overdrive READ with Kindle Fire or Kindle Fire HD

Kindle Fire will work with a feature called Overdrive Read that allows faster download of some titles. Overdrive Read allows you to read eBooks directly from a browser rather than downloading them. *If you have the original Kindle Fire model, you will need to install a third-party web browser as Kindle's Silk browser is not compatible with OverDrive Read.*

1. Visit the Kindle Fire **Appstore**.
2. Search **Browser for Kindle Fire**.
3. Select **Maxthon Mobile** (**Note:** there are other apps available, this is a highly rated free app, but other apps will work the same).
4. Tap **Free**.
5. Tap **Get App**.
6. Using the new browser app, go to <http://clc.lib.overdrive.com>.
7. Search for a title.
8. Tap desired book cover.
9. Tap **Borrow**.
10. Select the **Fairfield County District Library** option from the Library drop down menu.
11. Type your **Library Card Number** and **PIN** in the box and tap **Sign In**.
12. 16. Tap **Read (in your browser)**.
13. 17. A new tab will open with the book.
14. 18. Click or tap the right or left edges of the eBook to turn pages.
15. 19. Click or tap the **bookmark** icon in the upper-left to save your position.
16. 20. To access the menu options swipe down from (or click on) the top of the page.
17. 21. To read eBooks offline, follow this procedure:
 - a. Open the OverDrive Read title in the browser (**Maxthon Mobile** app, the Amazon Silk Browser is not a good match right now).
 - b. Tap the **Menu** Option to the left of the box where you type in the URL (it looks like a circle with a V in it).
 - c. Select **Add Favorite**.
 - d. Name the Bookmark, select **OK**.
 - e. Log off WiFi.
 - f. On the "Home" screen of the **Maxthon Mobile** app you will see menu bar running along the bottom of the page.
 - g. Select the **Folder with a Star** in the center.
 - h. Select the name of the Bookmark you created to open the title.
 - i. Read!
